

Fellowship Program 2019 for a Postdoc

Immunic Therapeutics offers a postdoctoral fellow program to support outstanding young scientists: This program offers a wonderful opportunity for scholars to engage in a two-year fellowship of interdisciplinary research.

Candidates must apply for the fellowship under the guidance of a Sponsor—a scientist (tenured, tenure-track or equivalent position) capable of providing mentorship to the Fellow. In addition to aiding in the planning, execution and supervision of the proposed research, the Sponsor's role is to foster the development of the Fellow's overall knowledge, technical and analytical skills, and capacity for scientific inquiry. The Sponsor is also expected to assist the Fellow in attaining his/her career goals.

Selection and Review

The Fellowship Award Committee of Immunic Therapeutics will review applications and select the candidates. The primary criteria used to evaluate applicants are:

- the quality of the research proposal (importance of the problem, originality of approach, appropriateness of techniques and clarity of presentation)
- the qualifications, experience and productivity of both the candidate and the Sponsor
- the quality of the research training environment in which the proposed research is to be conducted and its potential for broadening and strengthening the candidate's ability to independently conduct innovative and substantive research. The proposed research and training environment should represent a new opportunity for the candidate to expand his/her scientific skill set.

Eligibility Requirements

- Ph.D. degree
- Relevance of the research area to the portfolio of Immunic Therapeutics focusing on autoimmunity and immunotherapy.

Program Summary

- Immunic Therapeutics will provide annual expenses of \$74,000, covering stipend, fringe benefit and \$10,000 research budget that can be used for research activities such as research supplies, equipment, and conference and workshop travel.
- Fellows are appointed annually for up to two years.
- Fellows are required to write annual reports and to have a quarterly F2F or video meeting with CSO of Immunic Therapeutics to discuss the progress of the project.
